### 總幹事的話:

近期,相信圍繞著大家的其中 一個最主要的話題,就是在今年1 月30日,一位14歲的華裔少女在 家中服用芬太尼致死。少女的父 母痛問政府: 爲何不能强制戒 毒?其實,這不是第一,也不會是 最後一起少年人吸毒過量致死的 案例,如果毒品政策不調整的話。

早在2022年8月,高貴林港就 有一名 14 嵗少女 Sword, 在家中 臥室被發現吸毒過量死亡。

2024 年 1 月維多利亞大學一 年級的學生 Sidney, 也被發現在 校園宿舍因服用芬太尼中毒死 亡。

為了因應無法預測或受污染 的街頭阿片類藥物,有些醫生只 好開出另一種被視為「安全藥物」 的氫嗎啡酮 (hydromorphone)。不 幸的是,儘管這種處方藥也許沒 有受到污染,但它是一種效力不 亞於海洛英的鴉片劑,在喜七定 東街(East Hastings)60元買到40 粒(也就是每粒 1.5 元)的氫嗎啡 酮一點也不困難。

加,她的毒癮也越來越深,導致 她也去嘗試了芬太尼。她估計在 自己的校園内, 有一半的中學生 都在服用氫嗎啡酮或芬太尼。

由此可見,目前的毒品政策, 不是正在危害我們的孩子,而是 "已經"在危害了我們的孩子。但 是,我們可以爲了挽救我們的孩 子做些什麽呢?

我想,我們的個人力量是非 常有限的。我們應當集合力量,群 體發聲, 更重要的是利用我們手 中的一票,選出一個好政府來幫 助我們調整毒品政策。

然而,我們大多亞裔族群總 是抱著一種事不關己, 高高挂起 的心態: "我家沒孩子", "我孩 子很乖","我們的社區很安全" 等等。

果真事不關己嗎? 非也! 非 也! 筆者參與福音戒毒工作已有 33年了,在本地所創辦的福音戒 毒中心,也有12年的歷史了。

在這些年間,筆者確實親身 接觸過擁有碩士學位, 和來自富 室大家的吸毒者。這些都是住在 很安全的高尚住宅區的孩子,最

終還是難逃毒爪。

過去我曾幫助過、輔導過、約 見過的孩子,總是會在其家長的 口中聽到: "我的孩子是很乖 的,很聽話的,功課也很好,而且 自小就在教會長大。他就是交了 壞朋友,才開始染上毒癮。"

其實,以筆者 33 年的經驗,許 多少年人染上毒瘾, 九成九都是 因爲交了壞朋友。

而就我們之前介紹的少女 M 所説的,估計在校園内,有一半的 中學生都在服用氫嗎啡酮或芬太 尼。

在這毒品汎濫的環境, 以及 縱容毒品的政策之下,對於商家、 住宅、路人、老人所面對的爆竊、 偷盜、搶劫、無故傷人等事件,時 有所聞。

通過以上所述, 我們還能認 爲事不關己嗎?是事未達己罷 了!

除了以上所述我們所能做到 的,我想,身爲基督徒的我們更應 該常爲此事禱告。正如箴言書 16 章 3 節所說的: "你所做的,要 交托耶和華, 你所謀的, 就必成 就。"阿門。

#### **Words from Executive Director:**

I think one of the most heated topics around us recently is that on January 30th this year, a 14-years-old Chinese girl died at home after taking fentanyl. The parents of this young girl asked the government with great sorrow, "Why can't we have mandatory drug rehabilitation?" This is not the first, nor will it be the last case of a teenager dying of drug overdose, especially if the drug policy remains unchanged.

Back in August 2022, a 14-years-old girl named Sword was found dead of a drug overdose in her bedroom in Port Coquitlam.

In January 2024, Sidney, a first-year student at the University of Victoria, was found dead of a fentanyl overdose in her campus dormitory.

As a response to unpredictable or contaminated street opioids, some doctors resorted to prescribing an alternative, hydromorphone which is considered to be a "safe drug". Unfortunately, while maybe not contaminated, it is a opiate as potent heroin which can be sold at \$60 for 40 pills, i.e. \$1.50 per pills, on East Hastings.

M is a teenager who has been taking fentanyl since she was 12 years old. According to her personal experience, as her body tolerate to hydromorphone grew, so did her addiction. Eventually, she was led to use fentanyl. She estimate that half of her secondary school students were taking either hydromor-

It is clear that the current drug policy had already endanger our children, what can we do about it?

I think our individual influence is very limited. We should gather together, to speak out as a group. More importantly, by voting a good government could help us tighten the drug policy.

Most of us in the Asian community, however, have the mentality that it's none of my business: "My family doesn't have kids." "My kids are good." "My neighborhood is safe." etc.

Is it really none of your business? No! No, it is not! I have been involved in Gospel drug rehabilitation for 33 years. I am working with Breakthrough Missions Canada (BMC), a locally founded Gospel drug rehabilitation centre, for 12 years.

During these years, I did personally come into contact with drug addicts who are highly educated and come from wealthy families. These are young people who live in very safe and high class residential areas, but eventually they cannot escape from the claw of drugs.

The parents of the children I have helped, counselled, or met in the past always say, "My child is very good,

very obedient, does well in his school, and has grown up in the church since he was a child. It is only when he made bad friends that he started to become addicted to drugs."

In my 33 years of experience, 99% of the people who become addicted to drugs start when they associate with bad friends.

As the young girl M, whom we introduced earlier, said, she estimated that half of the middle school students in campus are taking hydromorphone or fentanyl.

In this drug-ridden environment, and with such a loose policy towards drug usage, it is not uncommon to hear of burglaries, thefts, robberies, and unprovoked attacks from time to time. Businesses, homes, passersby, elderly; anyone may become a victim.

Having said these, how can we still think that it is not our business? We may be next in line be the next victim!

In addition to what we can do, as mentioned above, I think, as Christians we should always keep praying over this matter. As Proverbs 16:3 says, "Commit to the Lord whatever you do, and He will establish your plans." Amen.
